

Private Barossa Tour for Thorngrove Guests

The Barossa Valley is one of Australia's best known wine regions and home to some of the oldest shiraz vines in the world. The region is dotted with the unmistakable presence of a rich Germanic heritage, where the culture is interwoven with modern Australia.

Our wine guide uncovers for our guests the amazing food and wine of the Barossa Valley. In the Barossa they can discover sweeping views of a gnarled landscape, and encounter charming producers of legendary delights. Enjoy regional wines which are robust, rich, and earthy with great lingering length.

With this full day tour you can experience the food, wine, and history of the region. You will have ample time for photo opportunities, and be immersed in the culture of the Barossa Valley.

You will be collected from Thorngrove Manor at 9:30am, and will be transported in luxury by your personal wine guide through the Adelaide Hills via the tiny township of Springton, then on to Henschke Wines in the Eden Valley. Henschke is the producer of one of Australia's icon Shiraz wines – Hill of Grace.

We will then progress on to the Barossa township of Angaston, and pause for morning tea in a local café. If you wish we can also visit Barossa Valley Cheese Company – the makers of many award winning cows and goats milk cheeses.

On the way to our next winery we will detour to the top of Mengler's Hill. From here you can gain a stunning panoramic view of the surrounding countryside and vineyards of Barossa Valley and the greater Barossa wine region.

Next we visit Langmeil Winery, who are the proud custodians of the world's oldest Shiraz vines. Their vineyard is set amongst one of the original villages of the region, and is complete with original shops of the era (eg blacksmiths, bakery, and cobbler). Our guests will be able to stroll through the vineyard and chat to their wine guide about viticulture, wine making and see these ancient vines. We will visit the Langmeil tasting room where our guests will be able to taste their super-premium range of wines.

A range of lunch options can be recommended and arranged.

Following lunch we will visit our next boutique winery –Torbreck Vintners. Torbreck is where traditional, manual winemaking methods with minimal intervention result in wines of international acclaim.

To complete the day we visit the boutique producers of Turkey Flat where we can purchase the wines which have made them celebrated at home and abroad.

This concludes our indulgent day in the Barossa Valley, before we return you to Thorngrove Manor by 5:30pm.
